

From Philadelphia International Airport:

SEPTA Airport Express Train: The Airport Express Train, R1, leaves every half-hour, stops at the various airport terminals, and will take you either to the University City Station on Convention Avenue

102 Meyerson Hall 210 South 34th Street Philadelphia, PA 19104 or to 30th Street Station. The fare is \$7.00, and the ride takes 18 minutes to the University City Station. Fares and schedules are available at the Transportation and Parking Office or the SEPTA Regional Rail web page.

Cars, Taxis, and Limousines at the Airport: A taxicab costs \$28.50 plus \$1 per additional passenger and tip. The ride takes about 20 minutes.

Lyft and Uber rideshare pick up Is available near the baggage claim area. The cost varies depending on time of day but Is comparable to a taxi.

From the Greyhound Trailways Bus Terminal:

The Bus Terminal is located at 11th & Filbert streets in Center City Philadelphia. Exit the terminal and walk one block south to Market Street to board the Market/Frankford Rail Line to 34th & Market streets. The fare is \$2.50 (exact change is required). Or transfer from the Market/Frankford Line at 30th Street Station to the Subway/Surface trolley (Routes 11, 13, 34, or 36) and stop at 36th & Sansom streets or 37th & Spruce street.
